The annual Christmas party was held at Club 48 on December 16, 2023. The weather was perfect as we have had a mild winter so far, there was no snow in sight.

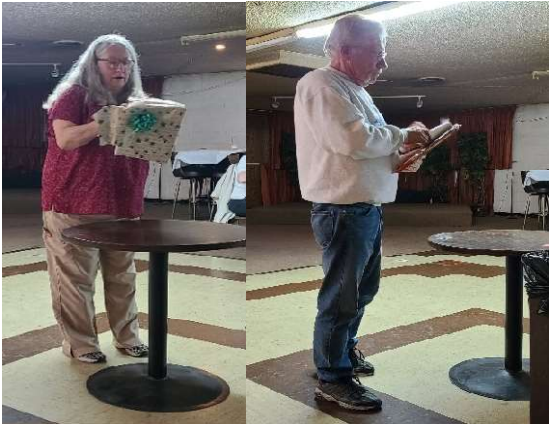
